SCHOOL SAFETY

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Emergency Management Plan has a number of steps to be followed to ensure the safety of all in the building. These procedures are discussed and practiced throughout the year so everyone is knowledgeable of what they should do in an emergency.

The three main components of the Emergency Management Plan are:

Evacuation – This is commonly referred to as a fire drill. A school may need to be evacuated for reasons other than fire, so we use the generic term 'evacuation'. We had our first drill this week.

Relocation If our had to school be for evacuated а significant period of time during the day, we would have all students and staff relocate another to building in the community. Currently, this is the local church.

Unlike an evacuation where everyone leaves the building, the goal of the lockdown procedure is to have everyone remain in the building. Although infrequent, the possibility а major incident creating situation а causing serious injury in our school is a possibility.

Lockdown Procedure -

There could be a hazardous leak outside the school, an animal loose in the building or in the general area, or a major health concern.
